Additional Information:

Past due support (arrears) and interest accrue any time the current support obligation is not paid in full during the month, and includes amounts established by a court as arrears.

If the family does not receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), child support payments collected are distributed to the custodial person. If your child(ren) live out of state, and the custodial person is either collecting public assistance or has requested the assistance of that state's child support enforcement agency, support is forwarded to that agency for appropriate disbursement.

Even if you are making regular payments to reduce the child support debt, Arizona and federal law authorizes the DCSS to use a full range of administrative enforcement actions to collect past due child support. Such actions include an action to suspend or deny a license pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-517, issuing a notice of levy against real or personal property pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-516, issuing a notice of levy against assets held by or on behalf of an obligor pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-521, issuing an Income Withholding Order or order to modify or terminate an Income Withholding Order pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-505.01, reporting an obligor to a consumer credit reporting agency pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-512, placement of a lien pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-516 and lottery winnings intercept pursuant to A.R.S. § 5-525.
