ARIZONA CASE CLOSURE NOTIFICATION

This notice is being sent to inform you that the Arizona Division of Child Support Services (DCSS) is closing its case due to one of the following reasons:

- There is no longer a current support order and the arrearages are under \$500/the order is unenforceable under state law.
- There is no longer a current support order and all arrearages in the case are assigned to the state.
- There is no longer a current support order, the children have emancipated, the support payor has entered long term care arrangements and has no income or assets available that could be levied or attached.
- The support payor is deceased.
- Paternity cannot be established.
- After diligent efforts, the support payor's location remains unknown.
- The support payor is incarcerated, is permanently disabled, or has been institutionalized in a psychiatric facility.
- The support payor is a citizen of and lives in a foreign country in which there is no treaty or reciprocity, does not work for the federal government or a company with offices in the United States, and has no reachable income or assets.
- The support payor is living with the minor child as the primary caregiver or in an intact two parent household.
- The support payor's sole income is from SSI or both SSI and SSDI.
- The IV-D applicant has requested case closure.
- A finding of Good Cause.
- Loss of contact with the IV-D applicant.

- [] The DCSS no longer needs intergovernmental services from your state.
