**Intergovernmental Referral Notice: Paternity and Establishment**

Dear CUSTODIAL TEST TEST,

The Division of Child Support Services (DCSS) has received your request and is currently working to provide child support services to you and your family. The other parent has been located in another state. The DCSS has requested assistance from that state's child support agency to assist in the establishment of paternity and/or a child support order. Due to issues with jurisdiction, the DCSS may be limited in the use of some child support actions, therefore a partnership with the other state is the most effective way to assist you.

During this process, we generally allow 90 days for the other state to respond to our request before we inquire about the case status. You may receive requests for information from the other state. Please inform your local DCSS case worker and provide the copies of any documents received. Your case worker will provide you with direction and/ or assistance. It is important that all information requests are completed and returned in a timely manner to avoid delays in processing your case.

Arizona will always be your point of contact. Do not contact the other state's child support agency unless you have been instructed to do so.
