

Article 10 of the Hague Convention

Article Number	Explanation / Description
Article 10 (1) a)	Application by the SR for recognition or recognition and enforcement of an existing order not made in the requested State.
Article 10 (1) b)	Application by the SR for enforcement of an existing order made or recognized in the requested State.
Article 10 (1) c)	Application by the SR for establishment of an order in the requested State, where no order exists.
Article 10 (1) d)	Application by the SR for establishment of an order in the requested State where recognition and enforcement of an existing order is not possible.
Article 10 (1) e)	Application by the SR for modification of an order made in the requested State.
Article 10 (1) f)	Application by the SR for modification of an order not made in the requested State.
Article 10 (2) a)	Application by the SP for recognition of an existing order or limitation of enforcement of an existing order, made in the requested State.
Article 10 (2) b)	Application by the SP for modification of an order made in the requested State.
Article 10 (2) c)	Application by the SP for modification of an order not made in the requested State.
