## **SUBJECT: The Dynamic Idea Generator (DIG) Standard Work**

This Policy FYI is to inform staff that the Dynamic Idea Generator (DIG) is an easier method to submit ideas. It's designed to increase the number of ideas implemented from 5 to 24 by DCSS Teams. Previously, the Success Wall was used to capture both success stories and newly implemented ideas.

The DIG will provide:

1. A centralized location where you can see everyone's ideas
2. A process to track ideas from start to implementation or closure
3. A quick response to ideas submitted to leadership

On March 1, 2023, the [DIG](#) will be used for new ideas with the goal for them to be implemented. The DIG will replace the Idea Register on Huddle Boards. Please review the Standard Work for the DIG as everyone has a role with corresponding expectations.
