SUBJECT: Policy FYI-488 | The Second Passport Revocation Update

This FYI is to update team members that, effective June 29, 2026, the Department of State (DOS) will begin the next phase of passport revocations for support payors (SP) with child support arrears above \$50,000.

The Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) clarified what happens when the SP has multiple cases, and specifically whether the OCSE considers arrears based on a single case or the combined total of all cases.

For the initial list used for the May 8, 2026, revocations, the OCSE included only SPs with at least one individual case with arrears of \$100,000 or more. (See [FYI-481](#))

The subsequent list for the \$50,000 and \$75,000 (See [FYI-485](#)) thresholds was based on the SPs arrears combined across all cases, including those individuals with debts in more than one state. As a result, these lists included SPs whose total eligible arrears met or exceeded the \$50,000 or \$75,000 thresholds.

The OCSE will continue to share information as it becomes available.
