The Supreme Court of the Navajo Nation recently issued an order recognizing Arizona's administrative process establishing paternity.

The Navajo Nation will now accept the CS-127 Acknowledgment of Paternity (AOP) filed by the Hospital Paternity Program (HPP) of the Division of Child Support Enforcement (DCSE), and the Affidavit Acknowledging Paternity (AAP) filed by DCSE to establish paternity.
