The DCSS was recently made aware that it can take up to three months for an inmate to receive notary services while incarcerated. In an effort to process modification requests more efficiently, our colleagues at the Attorney General's Office (AGO) have agreed to stop requiring an agreement to accept service by mail for incarcerated NCPs.

The elimination of this document will streamline the process and have an immediate impact on this specific population of our clients.
