## **SUBJECT:** Protecting the Address Confidentiality Program (ACP) Client

The ACP requirements prohibit the participant's address from appearing in the case record. This requirement is necessary to provide protection to the ACP participant.

Why is this important to the DCSS staff? As Department of Economic Security employees, we have a responsibility to address these cases with the utmost caution. When updating information on cases in which the CP or NCP is flagged as an ACP participant, do not enter a residential address in a CAAL narrative. If the party states that they are no longer participating in the ACP or would like to update their address for any other reason, take the following steps:

- 1. Write down the updated address information and store it in a secure location.
- 2. Verify that the residential address on CPDE/NCDE is:

1901 W. Madison St.

Apt. # \_\_\_\_ (the apartment number will be different for each person) Phoenix, AZ 85009

3. Send an email to <a href="DCSS-ACP@azdes.gov">DCSS-ACP@azdes.gov</a> which includes the ATLAS #, the name of the ACP party and the reason for the address update request.
