SUBJECT: Intergovernmental Status Codes

The I/R field(s) on the Case Status (CAST) screen indicates whether the case is initiating, responding, or local. The codes for these fields are:

- **I 1** Initiating – One State action; Long-Arm Jurisdiction. The case is worked within Arizona.
- **I 2** Initiating - Two State action; outgoing. A request for services has been sent to another jurisdiction and the other jurisdiction has opened an intergovernmental case with Arizona.
- **I 3** Initiating – Three State action, outgoing. There is an open intergovernmental case with one jurisdiction and a limited services request is sent to a different jurisdiction.
- **R 2** Responding - Two State action; incoming. A request for services has been received by another jurisdiction and Arizona has opened an intergovernmental case with that jurisdiction.
- **R 3** Responding - Three State action; incoming. There is an open intergovernmental case with one jurisdiction and a limited services request or a request to collect assigned arrears is sent to Arizona by another jurisdiction.
- **Blank** – In-State (local)

The “I” status code shall be used when the custodial parent (CP) and the child live in one jurisdiction (usually Arizona) but the non-custodial parent lives outside Arizona.

The “R” status code shall be used when the noncustodial parent lives in Arizona and an initiating jurisdiction has requested Arizona to open a IV-D case.
