The Policy Unit is excited to introduce new forms that were recently added to the PORT. They include all of the Hague Convention documents and Spanish-English intergovernmental forms.

The Spanish-English forms were provided by the federal Office of Child Support Enforcement to be used when initiating a case to Mexico. These forms include a separate document called "Requisitos UIFSA 2015-Required Documents for Referral to Mexico". This is a list of all of the forms required by Mexico to open an intergovernmental case. When initiating an enforcement case, remember to send a copy of the certified translated order in Spanish to Mexico as well as the original certified copy of the support order.

All of these forms, with the exception of the checklist, are fillable and printable.
