

## SUBJECT: SSN on OCSE Issued Pre-Offset Notice

Effective November 2019, the Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) will mask the noncustodial parent's full Social Security Number (SSN) on its Pre-Offset Notice (PON). This change is a result of the Social Security Number Fraud Prevention Act of 2017, that restricts the inclusion of SSNs on documents federal agencies send by mail.

The SSN will now be displayed on the PON with all asterisks. (i.e., SSN previously displayed as \*\*\*-\*\*-6789 will now be displayed as \*\*\*-\*\*-6789 will now be displayed as \*\*\*-\*\*-
