SUBJECT: Identifying Caretaker Cases

Caretakers are relatives or nonrelatives designated by the custodial parent to take care of the child(ren). Caretaker cases may be identified in several ways:

- Compare the Mother's and Father's Names fields on the first panel of the CHDE (Child Demographics) screen to the CP and NCP names on the case.
- Compare the Bio/Adoptive Mother Name and Bio/Adoptive Father Name fields on the BIPI (Bio/Adoptive Parents Information) screen to the CP and NCP names on the case.
- Review the Child Relationship to the CP field on the PACC (Paternity-Child Case) screen. If the field contains any value other than SOD (Son or Daughter), it is a caretaker case and ATLAS will generate the activity code CT010 CP=CRTKR PACC UPDATED.
