This FYI is to inform staff a newly released Administrative Order (AO 2022-34) has been issued by the Supreme Court of Arizona which modifies Administrative Order 2020-59. Rule 14(a) of this order (AO 2020-59) allows the DCSS to accept some documents without notarization if they are accompanied by a photocopy of the filer's driver license or other government-issued identification card. This rule will remain in effect until December 31,2022.

All versions of the **Agreement to Accept Service by Mail** are included in the temporary waiver (of notarization) allowed by Rule 14(a).

The list below includes all forms that still require notarization and are not impacted by AO 2020-59, Rule 14(a).

Waiver of Support	FCSE0001F0522	Notarization required by A.R.S. § 25-510
