SUBJECT: Tucson Minimum Wage Increase April 1, 2022

This Policy FYI is to inform staff that effective April 1, 2022, the City of Tucson passed an initiative ballot increasing the Minimum wage to \$13.00 per hour. Use the \$13.00 per hour rate when assigning minimum wage in cases for establishment or modification with court dates of April 1, 2022, or later.

Future minimum wage increases for Tucson are set for the following.

- ~~\$13.50~~ by January 1, 2023, *(This will now be \$13.85 in accordance with statute)*
- \$14.25 by January 1, 2024,
- \$15.00 by January 1, 2025, and
- Increased by the rate of inflation rounded to the nearest multiple of \$0.05 every January thereafter.
