**SUBJECT:** New Nevada Child Support Enforcement System

The Policy Unit would like to inform staff that the Nevada Child Support Enforcement Program is transitioning to a new computer system called NVKIDS. There will be roughly 7,300 cases converted to the new system which will generate CSENetS to any intergovernmental partner associated with those cases. The new case number structure will be 10 digits beginning with NV FIPS Code 32.

The new case number structure is listed below for reference:

- NVKIDS **case number** will be 10 digits beginning with 32(NV FIPS Code) i.e., **3200333045**
- Each case **participant** will have a unique 10digit number beginning with 1 i.e., **1000936249**

As new discoveries are made during this transition to the new NCSE system, communication will be relayed. This is set to take place April 4, 2022, through October 2022.
