All automated enforcement actions shall be suppressed when arrears exist **solely** because the CP has not been located.

When a check issued to the CP is returned and the SNLO Receipt Narrative is added to the case:

- 1. Review DELN to see if there are any arrears.
 - a. When the suspended receipt has a prior month SRD, display the DEHA records for the SRD month.
- 2. When arrears exist, do not suppress any enforcement actions.
- 3. When arrears do not exist, suppress all automatic enforcement actions on the SUDE (Suppression Detail) screen.
