Last month, 2,218 letters were mailed to Child Care Administration (CCA) recipients to offer IV-D services if their case is not known to ATLAS. These letters will be sent to new CCA recipients on a monthly basis. If their case is open on ATLAS, a request for locate information is generated and the Case Activity (CAAL) code **CC001 CHILD CARE REFERRAL AND REQUEST FOR LOCATE LETTER SENT** is added to the case. If the ATLAS case is closed with a 927 (Non Coop/Nec for Next Action) or 912 (Loss of Contact) closure code, a letter offering IV-D services is generated with the CAAL code **CC002 CHILD CASE REFERRAL.** All other closed cases did not receive a letter.

If a CCA recipient comes into any DCSE office with a letter offering IV-D services, staff shall provide a IV-D application. If a CP comes into the office with a request for locate letter, staff shall update ATLAS with the information provided and review the case for the next appropriate action.
