<u>Starting on May 1, 2006</u>, Florida's Child Support Enforcement program will have a new 1-866 line dedicated to answering calls from IV-D CSE offices across the United States.

Florida's new number for IV-D CSE employees is:

1-866-SUPPFLA (787-7352)

This number is only for use by IV-D CSE employees across the United States. When calling this number you will be routed directly to a Customer Contact Center Representative. You will not be placed in a queue. If all lines happen to be busy, your call will be routed to a voicemail account. If your call goes to the voicemail account, please remember to include your name, the case you are calling about and a direct contact telephone number. If you have to leave voicemail, a Customer Contact Center Representative will attempt to return your will within 48 hours. It is important that this number not be given out to custodial or non-custodial parents, otherwise the effectiveness of the line will be compromised. Custodial and non-custodial parents will continue to call Florida's 1-800-622-KIDS number for assistance.
