A custodial parent (CP) cannot withdraw from IV-D services when a court order for current support is in effect and state assigned arrears have not been paid in full. A CP does not have the option to ask the state to stop collecting a current support obligation that has not been terminated by a court new order or by law when the last child on the court order emancipates.

Do not stop the accrual on an existing child current support debt if a CP requests that DCSE no longer enforce or collect the current support amount if arrears are owed to the state.

A CP may request that the IV-D case be closed only if that case meets defined closure criteria. Closure criteria is found in the On-Line Policy and Procedure Manual (OPPM), <http://dcsepc> under **CLOSURE**.
