DCSE has received guidance from the Federal Office of Child Support Enforcement that the IV-D program cannot enforce judgments for lying In costs. These judgments are coded with the JLI obligation type on the DEDN and DELN screens in ATLAS. OCSE has determined that enforcement of these judgments is not a IV-D function. Therefore, all JLI judgments on ATLAS have been deactivated. Procedures to address JLI obligations in new calculations will be addressed by Policy within a few days.
