Based on guidance from Federal Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE), all JLI debts have been deactivated on ALAS. This PPU is being issued to clarify how to address a JLI debt that has been recorded.

- If the JLI debt is not paid, a lien obtained by DCSE should be released, not satisfied.
- If the JLI debt is paid in full, the judgment should be satisfied.
- If the JLI debt is combined with a Past Support Judgment (PSJ) obligation, and the entire amount is not paid, the lien cannot be released or satisfied.
