This PPU is to provide an update for processing JLI obligations on ATLAS and the DRU.

DEDN and SUOD

The JLI (Judgment for Lying in Costs) Obligation Code is now Inactive on **DEDN** as well as the LIC (Judgment for Lying in Costs) Judgment Type Code on Panel Two of **SUOD**. This means that staff can no longer enter these obligations and judgments on ATLAS. When adding a court order that includes a Judgment for Lying-in Expenses, document on the **SUOD Comments** field the details of the judgment.

Do not delete any existing LIC records from **Panel Two** of the **SUOD** screen.

Do not reapply any payments that distributed to JLI debts.

DRU Processing

As of 7/01/2009, no payments will apply to JLI debts on the DRU.

The **DRU** will still set up JLI debts when they exist on **SUOD**. Those JLI debts will remain active on the **DRU** calculation to display any payments that had applied to them in the past.

The JLI debts will continue to accrue interest on the **DRU**. Remember – Judgments for Lying in Costs is still a valid court ordered obligation, an OCSE interpretation determined that they are simply no longer enforceable by Title IV-D.

When the IV-D case is closed the Clerk of Court can still collect on JLI obligations.
