Automation is in place which allows ATLAS to determine a child's emancipation date. Except for cases with a tribal or international order, the Emancipation Date in the second panel of the Child Demographic (**CHDE**) screen is automatically calculated based on the child's date of birth, high school graduation date, state emancipation, and emancipation override information.

The Division of Child Support Services (DCSS) is not dependent on the custodial parent (CP) for emancipation information. When a CP does not return the emancipation letter, the case does not meet the federal definition of non-cooperation and is not eligible for closure.
