This Policy Update provides guidance to staff regarding communicating with a CP or NCP who currently is or was formerly represented by an attorney.

CP or NCP is Currently Represented

- DCSS and County Partner staff may communicate directly with the CP or NCP.
- The AG/County Attorney may communicate directly with the CP or NCP on a limited basis and only with their attorney's permission.
- During a legal action, the AG/County Attorney will communicate with the CP or NCP's attorney only.

CP or NCP was Formerly Represented

- DCSS and County Partner staff may communicate directly with a CP or NCP who was formerly represented by an attorney.
- The AG/County Attorney will independently verify whether or not the CP or NCP is still represented by an attorney before communicating directly with them.

CP or NCP has Never Been Represented

- DCSS and County Partner staff may communicate directly with the CP or NCP as they are considered a party in Title IV-D actions.
- The AG/County Attorney may communicate directly with the CP or NCP and will make sure the parties understand the role of the AG/County Attorney in their case.
