The Policy Unit is pleased to announce the SROP-Suspense Retro Overpayment Suspense Code procedure has been revised. The revised procedure incorporates minor changes for clarity and consistency relating to a completed Debt Recalculation Utility (DRU).

A DRU is not necessary until a case is ready to close, but debts should still be reviewed for accuracy.

If reviewing for case closure, review for paid in full. Cases should be calculated when a calculation has not been completed in the last 12 months. When the court order is a foreign order contact the other state to obtain an arrears balance. SROP receipt will move to SFTO suspense status overnight if not worked the same day.
