

SUBJECT: PPU-24-05-001 | Non-Cooperation Policy - Extension of AHCCCS Temporary Waiver

The purpose of this Policy Update is to alert staff that the temporary waiver in place with AHCCCS, which suspended the requirement for customers to cooperate with the Division of Child Support Services (DCSS) in establishing the identity of a child's parents as a condition of Medicaid eligibility—at renewals and when a change occurs, has been extended through 12/31/2024. This waiver was initially set to expire on 5/31/24 but has been extended to 12/31/2024. This Policy Update supersedes PPU-23-10-001 issued on 10/12/2023.

We have added information about the temporary waiver extension to the DCSS Non-Cooperation Policy.

The DCSS may continue to receive referrals for these cases during the waiver period.
